

Scheduled for June 2019 – Babies Section

Reminder:

This month, the nursery will be closed on **10/06** (public holiday)

The end-of-year party will take place on **20/06**.

Continuing our educational programme, our team of nursery carers will stimulate the children's development through the **"five senses"** while helping them to discover their environment by offering suitable **sensory activities**. These activities will take various formats and will focus on one or several senses at the same time.

During June, the team of nursery carers in the Babies class will offer a wide variety of activities. Various handling activities will be offered, including in particular **"yoghurt painting"** and **"salt dough"**. Logical and early learning activities will also take place with a workshop involving the **"box with holes in"**, and an assembly game which will stimulate their grip as well as their assembly and fine motor skills. The children will also get the chance to take part in a **"surprise activity"** and to marvel at the **"light table"**.

Given the importance of free play and free exploration of the environment in the children's development, they will also be provided with suitable toys and games for their age: rattles, musical instruments, toy cars, books, pull-along toys, abacuses, spinning tops, scarves, animal stacking games, tea sets, etc.

The culinary activity will take place every Thursday and will help develop the children's sense of taste, smell and touch. This month, the culinary activities will revolve around the discovery of certain spices, vegetables or aromatic herbs: discovering **radish, chives, cinnamon** and **cucumber** will be part of the programme.

The **psychomotor activity**, which will take place on Wednesdays, will support the children in their motor skills development and allow them to understand their body better spatially.

The **Chaise Musicale** workshop will take place on 17th June 2019.

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Scheduled for June 2019 – Toddlers Section

This month, the nursery carers in this class have chosen to tackle the theme of the **weather** with the children.

The children will get the chance to discover the theme thanks to picture books, **artistic and creative activities** (crafts, etc), **drawing, handling** and **fine motor skills** workshops, etc. The nursery carers will also offer **surprise activities**.

Alongside this theme, and taking into account the importance of free play in their development, the children will be offered various games, such as construction games (Kapla, Lego, blocks, etc), imaginative play (dolls, tea sets, etc), board games (puzzles, etc), dressing up, musical instruments, etc.

The **culinary activity** will take place every Wednesday. This month, our young chefs will get the chance to make **shortbread**, a **Caesar salad** and a **pasta salad**.

The **psychomotor activity** will take place every Tuesday. This will help the children stimulate their motor skills development and their understanding of space and social interaction.

The **Chaise Musicale** workshop will take place on 17th June 2019.

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Scheduled for June 2019 – School Section

The end-of-year party will take place on 20/06.

This month, the team has chosen to tackle two themes: “**pirates**” and “**castles**”.

The theme of **pirates** will be introduced during the first two weeks of the month, alternating with surprise activities: picture books, creative workshops, a treasure hunt, making a pirate ship, fine motor skills workshops and reading stories will be part of the programme.

Finally, the last two weeks of the month will be dedicated to a theme that really fascinates the children in this class: **castles**. Picture books, colouring in, association games, drawing, craft workshops, memory games, and making a giant castle will be some of the activities offered.

Alongside these activities, and given the importance of free play for the children’s development, they will be offered various games, such as **construction games** (Kapla, Lego, blocks, etc), **imaginative play** (tea sets, dolls, puppets, etc), **board games** (puzzles, logical games, shape sorting games, etc), as well as suitable books for their age.

During the **culinary activities** every Friday this month, our young chefs will make a **pirate cake**, **salmon toast**, a **gingerbread castle** and a **chicken quiche**.

The **psychomotor activity** will take place every Thursday. This will allow the children to improve their coordination and to understand their body better spatially and social interaction.

The **Chaise Musicale** workshop will take place on 17th June 2019.

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
